

In addition to the General Regulations of the National Syllabus please note the following local information:

- **Southwark and East Surrey Area NOW REQUIRES an accompanist to attend the exam with the candidate.**
- A medal and certificate is included in the entry fee. The entry fee should be made by BACS::

- There is no refund for unsuccessful candidates.
- Entering the exam is only possible via the form on www.rscmsouthwark.org.uk and the application should be returned via post. Please do not attempt any registration on line at this time.
- The exam is normally divided in two parts, the singing sections A, B, C then the spoken part section E. This is normally undertaken in two different rooms in two separate sections. On occasions, a wait between these two sections is unavoidable.
- Successful candidates in session one are offered the opportunity to receive their ribbon by post after the results are issued. Successful candidates in session 2 must wait for the presentation service in September before being awarded their ribbon. Certificates are only ever issued at the presentation service each September.
